

Lionel E. Simmons - New Treasurer Of IPMI

Lionel E. Simmons - New Treasus Lionel E. Simmons and his Company, the Simmons Refining Company, was one of the original six Charter Patron Members who supported the organization of the International Precious Metals Institute. Since the organization of PIMI in 1976, Mr. Simmons has served on its Board of Directors. He has now increased his participation in IPMI by accepting the position as Treasurer for the 1980-81 year.

Lionel E. Simmons was born in Chicago, Illinois on July 25, 1920. He received his indoctrination in precious metals by working weekends and summers at an early age for his father, a manufacturing jeweler. He attended the University of Chicago, majoring in chemistry. With his background and education, he opened a small refinery in 1940 to service the jewelry trade in Chicago. At the outbreak of World War II, Mr.

IPMI To Honor Students Engaged In Precious Metals Research

The Board of Directors of the International Procious Metals Institute have announced a newly established "IPMI STUDENT AWARD". This Award, which consists of a \$500 heorarium and a certificate citing the recipient's contributions, is intended to recognize and encourage outstanding work performed by a student in precious metals research.

Nominations are open to graduate and undergraduate students of all nationalities engaged in research on any one of the eight precious metals or alloys. The research program should be original and may be part of a graduate or undergraduate thesis program.

Nominations will be accepted from bonafide members of school faculties with a minimum one page review of the student's work. The work may have been published or presented within the prior 12 months, but this is

not required for consideration. For the current year, nominations must be submitted to IPMI by February 1, 1981. A committee of distinguished international authorities on precious metals will review the papers and make the selection. The Award will be presented at the Annual International Totalitation of the Conference of the Institute, held in May or June of each institute, held in May or June of each

year.

Nominations should be sent to the Chairman, Awards Committee, IPMI, Polytechnic Institute of New York, 333 Jay Street, Brooklyn, New York 11201. Dr. Sheldon Weinig, President, Materials Research Corporation, is the Chairman of the Awards Committee.

Simmons put his equipment aside and enlisted in the Air Force. As a navigator, he participated in the African, Sicilian, Italian and D-Day

After the war, Mr. Simmons and his English bride, Margaret, started a family and reopened the Simmons Refining Company. The Company is now recognized as a major refiner of all precious metals.

Mr. Simmons is knowledgeable and conversant on all aspects of precious metals (assaying, metallurgy, mining, refining and training). He is a member of the Precious Metals Committee of the National Association of Recycling Industries (NARI) and Treasurer of the International Precious Metals Institute (IPMI), Mr. Simmons has contributed many articles on precious metals to the trade papers and he wrote the monograph of the six platinum metals for the Chemical and Process Technological Encyclopedia published by McGraw-Hill.


