ANNA Report

Founded in 1970 as Ammonium Nitrate Pollution Study Group, ANNA is the leading association active in Ammonia Nitrate and Nitric Acid businesses. Primarily based in the USA, the first conference outside North America took place in Europe in 2010 and was attended by 380 people.

This September ANNA held its annual conference in Vienna, Austria. Attended by over 460 delegates, representing 59 producers and with 84 exhibitors the conference was a big success.

IPMI also had a chance to present itself and speak about precious metals in nitric acid industry, as without PGMs conversion of ammonia into nitric acid would not be possible. Zibi Milkiewicz, Member of IPMI Board of Directors and at the same time serving as Sales Director at Krastsvetmet held a presentation which was divided into three parts. First IPMI as active player in global precious metals business was introduced to all the audience. Then some facts about precious metals were shared, which included price forecasts and applications. The final part was presenting results of a survey conducted by IPMI among nitric acid plants. The survey referred to metals applications, price sensitivity, leasing vs. owning metal, substituting of precious metals and technical adaptions as a result of rising prices.

We look forward to working more closely with ANNA and hope to see this renown association and their members at IPMI's future event.

Heraeus Precious Metals Hosts Its 4th Industry Forum in New York City


